Application process, 3 steps

Step 1 Submit

- **all requested documents** via the Online Portal, through the links above and receive a PDF version of their application summary, before Oct 15

Step 2 Ask your professor to:

- fill out the reference form (available on the [DAAD portal](#))
- send the signed reference form via email to gradscholar@daad.org
- give you a hard-copy of the signed reference form in a sealed envelope

Step 3 - Submit

- **a paper copy and a PDF file** of your on line application and the signed reference in a sealed envelope to York's **DAAD Campus Advisor, Prof Jenny Wüstenberg** by email and in hard copy (jwustenb@yorku.ca) (Department of Politics, South Ross, 6th floor)
