Building on the successful 2017 programme, in 2018 the summer school will focus on the interplay between economic freedoms and human rights and how that shapes the EU's global role.


The programme provides unique networking opportunities and receptions, all whilst earning 5 ECTS in a supportive, structured and open academic environment.
