

# Global Affairs Canada Scholarship Opportunities (Guide for Students)

---

**Global Affairs Canada's Student Exchange Program (GACSEP)** is an annual award that supports study, research and professional development activities in Canada.

The following scholarships are open for undergraduate and graduate students, university staff and faculty members.

**NOTE:** York International (YI) centrally coordinates applications and nominations to the above awards as required by the Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE).

**Deadline to submit YI GAC nomination is Mon April 9, 2018 4:00 pm.**

## How to apply

Application procedures are outlined below.

### A. Taking courses at York

- Only students from [York's exchange partners](#) are eligible to take courses at York funded by GACSEP as the scholarship requires York to 'waive tuition and/or academic fees for selected students'.
- Exchange agreement balances will be taken into consideration when determining if a nomination can be submitted to Global Affairs Canada. Interested students must contact their institution's exchange coordinator who will then liaise with York International.
- Refer to the application process in Box 1.

1. Latin American and Caribbean Students contact their exchange coordinator



2. Home exchange coordinator submits YI *Global Affairs Canada Scholarship Application and Privacy Notice*



3. YI reviews applications & nominates to CBIE on behalf of York University.



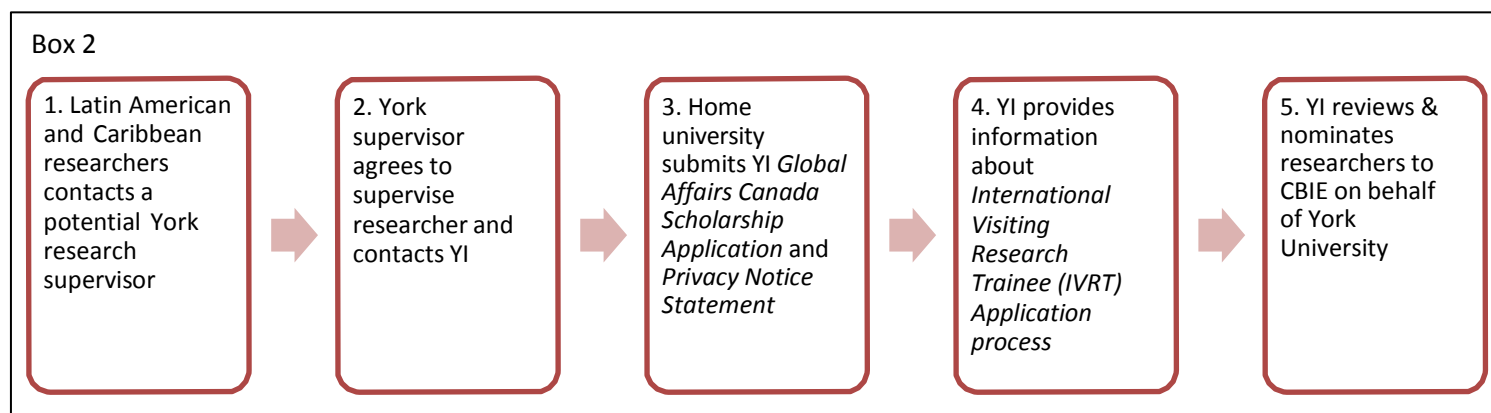
4. Nominated students submit a YI *Incoming Exchange Application*

#### **B. Conducting research and professional development at York**

- Agreement between the candidate's Home Institution and York University is not required for this category.
- Individuals who are interested to conduct research and professional development at York must contact and secure a York faculty member who will agree to supervise them.
- The candidate and the York supervisor will work together on the GACSEP application requirements and submit them to York International.
