**Application process, 3 steps**

**Step 1 Submit**

- **all requested documents** via the **Online Portal**, by and receive a PDF version of their application summary (before Oct 15, 2018)

**Step 2 Ask your professor to:**

- fill out the reference form (available on the [DAAD portal](#))
- get a hard-copy of the signed reference form in a sealed envelope

**Step 3 - Submit**

- **a paper copy and a PDF file** of your on line application and the signed reference in a sealed envelope to York's **DAAD Campus Advisor, Prof Jenny Wüstenberg** by email and in hard copy ([jwustenb@yorku.ca](mailto:jwustenb@yorku.ca)) (Department of Politics, South Ross, 6th floor)
