Since this program is only for <u>undergraduate students possessing an intermediate or advance level of Japanese language proficiency (JLPT N1/N2/N3, CEFR A2/B1/B2/C1/C2)</u>, please include this factor in the assessment of students when deciding on their ranking. All things being equal, we strongly recommend that students with an elementary or advanced level of Japanese language proficiency be ranked lower than those with intermediate proficiency.

IMPORTANT: Please be aware that we will accept a maximum of 10 participants from a single university.

(2. Transfer credits for Japanese language classes)

NUSTEP offers intermediate Japanese language classes (90 minutes per class, 22.5 hours in total) and a final exam. Should you wish to consider the possibility of transfer of credits to your institution then, upon request, we can provide syllabi and explain how student performance is assessed. Nagoya University will issue a certificate for all participants who pass the final exam.
