- 1. Return tickets for international flight (Economy);
- 2. Full accommodation (during the length of program);
- 3. Financial allowance for three months;
- 4. Health insurance (standard/limited);
- 5. Domestic flights to and from the destination city.

- 1. Curriculum Vitae;
- 2. Letter of recommendation from the respective university;
- 3. Health statement from family doctor;
- 4. Copy of passport;
- 5. 2 (two) copies of passport size photos.
