## **Field/Subject Area:**

Open to all York students who meet the eligibility criteria

## **Position Description:**

The intern will be responsible for helping systematize manuals for grassroots educators for workshops with youth between the ages of 14 -25 years old on various themes such as environment, analysis of Salvador reality, economic alternatives, gender, human rights, etc. The intern will also be responsible for developing and co-facilitating some of the workshops with CIS grassroots organizing team.

## **Specific tasks will include:**

- Helping develop, implement and systematize evaluation and report process with CIS youth formation and Scholarship Program.
- Systematization of formation workshops with youth carried out by CIS organizers.
- Helping to develop and facilitate workshops with CIS grassroots organizing team.

**Complete all tasks assigned, which includes but is not limited to the responsibilities outlined above.**

**Expected work hours:** 8 hours per day, 5 days a week

**Preferred starting date:** June 1; it is strongly preferred that all CIS interns begin work on the same date.

**Qualifications/skills required:**

- Writing, editing, layout, and/or graphic design
- Facilitation and/or education skills
- Knowledge of general history and current reality of El Salvador

**Language requirements:**

- Advanced Spanish - written and/or oral skills
