

# Global Affairs Canada Scholarship Opportunities (Guide for York Faculties)

---

## Overview

Global Affairs Canada supports students and researchers in Latin American, the Caribbean and Southeast Asia annually to study, research and conduct professional development activities in Canada. There are five (5) scholarships which are open for undergraduate and graduate students, university staff and faculty members.

Information about eligibility and application requirements are available on the pages of the individual scholarship programs as mentioned below. York International (YI) centrally coordinates applications and nominations to the above awards as required by the Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE).

## How to apply

### (1) Taking courses at York

Only students from [York's exchange partners](#) are eligible to take courses at York funded by GACSEP as the scholarship requires York to 'waive tuition and/or academic fees for selected students and researchers'. Exchange agreement balances will be taken into consideration when determining if a nomination can be submitted to Global Affairs Canada. Interested students must contact their institution's exchange coordinator who will then liaise with York International. Refer to **Table 1** for an overview of the application process.

**NOTE:** for interested universities and higher education institutions in Latin America, the Caribbean and Southeast Asia that are not currently an exchange partner institution of York: If you are currently not in the list of York University's institutional exchange partners, you are encouraged to connect with York Faculties to determine academic partnership interest. Please also consider that the process of establishing institutional agreement requires the support of a York Faculty and may take between 4 – 6 months inclusive of drafting, review and signatures.

**Table 1: Taking Courses at York**

1. Latin American and Caribbean Students contact their exchange coordinator



2. Submit a *Global Affairs Canada Scholarship Application* and *Privacy Notice Statement*



3. Submit a York International *Incoming Exchange Application*



4. York International nominates students to CBIE on behalf of York University

**(2) Conducting graduate research and professional development at York**

Agreement between the candidate's home institution and York University is not required for this category. Individuals who are interested to conduct research and professional development at York must contact and secure a York faculty member who will agree to supervise them. The candidate and the York supervisor will work together on the GACSEP application requirements and submit them to York International. Refer **Table 2** below for an overview of the application process.

**Table 2: Graduate Research and Professional Development**

1. Latin American and Caribbean researchers makes contact with a potential York supervisor



2. York supervisor agrees to supervise researcher and contacts YI



3. York supervisor and researcher submit a *Global Affairs Canada Scholarship Application* and *Privacy Notice Statement*



4. YI provides information about *International Visiting Research Trainee (IVRT) Application process*



5. York International nominates researcher to CBIE on behalf of York University
