




History Highlights of Hanyang




Special Scholarship

International Health/Travel Insurance

- 1) Submit at least 2 weeks before the program
- 2) Or purchase via Hanyang (Group rate: around 25,000 KRW)
- 3) This year, we strongly recommend students to purchase an insurance which also covers the medical fees for COVID-19.

Korean nationals



- 1) Submit at least 2 weeks before the program
- 2) Or purchase via Hanyang HISS Team (Group rate: around 25,000 KRW)

*How to request reimbursement for my medical service fees?



Visit near clinic/hospital and get medical services.



Upon payment, request an itemized bill for your treatment.




File a health insurance claim to your insurance company

Late-paying students may be required to email a bank transaction receipt to proceed to the next step.












K-ETA / C-3 Tourist Visa

Consult with the Korean Embassy or

Korean Consulate for the documents

required for VISA application.

- Students from a visa-waiver country need to apply for K-ETA(Korea Electronic Travel Authorization) prior to your boarding.
- Students from countries that are excluded from the Visa Waiver Agreement program must apply for a tourist visa (C-3).
- Students who wish to stay longer than your tourist visa expiry date may request for D-2-8 student visa.



Obtain documents provided by Hanyang University.

- 1) Certificate of Admission / Invitation Letter
- 2) Certificate of Business Registration of Hanyang
- *All the documents will be issued upon student's request.

Visit the Korean Embassy or Korean Consulate Office in the country you are currently studying at to apply for the C-3 or D-2-8 VISA to Korea.
