

Sogang University was established by the Society of Jesus in 1960 to provide an education based on Catholic beliefs and inspired by the Jesuit philosophy of education, in conformity with the Korean tradition of education.


In spite of its relatively short history, Sogang University has established its place as one of the top universities in Korea. There are 27 departments within 7 colleges offered in the undergraduate program compromised of 8,000 students and 418 full-time, tenure-track professors.

With its strong bond with more than 380 partner universities around the world, Sogang hosts about 400 incoming exchange students and sends 200 outgoing exchange students per year.



- After creating an account, fill in the online application form for SISP 2023 and submit required documents as listed below
- Confirmation e-mail will be sent along with an invoice within a week after application
- Make the payment according to the invoice. After payment, you will receive a welcome e-mail attached with a receipt and an admission letter
- Follow further instructions mentioned in the welcome letter to submit additional documents

GONZAGA HALL (OPTIONAL)
