

# Setting Financial Expectations

# What does it mean to study in Canada as an international student?

- > Finances are so important!
- Planning ahead is crucial to success.
  - Think about your full degree, not just your first year.
- Anticipating the unexpected can help ease stress.
- Limits to scholarships and bursaries.
- Prioritizing your financial education is so valuable.



# **General Expenses**

International student costs can range from \$30,000 - \$40,000 CAD a year depending on personal preferences, academic programs, etc.

Full-time tuition for most programs (5 courses + all supplementary* fees)	\$33,791 - for most programs \$31,552 - Design \$35,306 - Business \$35,997 - Commerce \$31,146 - Computer Science \$38,826 - Engineering
Textbooks and supplies (estimated)	\$1,200 - \$2,600 varies by program
Residence (traditional single room for 8 months)**	\$7,512
Meal plan (8 months, mandatory if living in some residences)	\$2,900 to 5,750
Personal expenses living on campus (entertainment and other)	\$1,600
Living off campus (apartment rental, utilities, meals)	\$12,500
Personal expenses if living off campus (entertainment, transportation)	\$4,000
Health and dental care Most students belong to the York Federation of Students (YFS) health plan.	\$1026 ( <u>UHIP</u> plus YFS or Glendon Plan. For updates to UHIP visit <u>YI</u> .)

# SCHOLARSHIPS, AWARDS AND BURSARIES

**Entrance Awards** – will be applied to recipients' York student account prior to the Fall tuition due date; you must be enrolled and have applied the registration deposit for the funds to be applied.

The **Student Financial Profile (SFP)** is a multi-purpose online application form that is used to apply for:

- > Undergraduate Scholarships and Awards Deadline has now passed
- > Work/Study, LEAP and RAY
- > York University Undergraduate Bursary program Deadline information can be found at <u>https://sfs.yorku.ca/aid/sfp</u>

The SFP opens on the first week of August for Fall/Winter programs and in early April for Summer programs.



# **UNDERGRADUATE BURSARY PROGRAM**

York University's Undergraduate Bursary program is a **financial needs based** program. Intention of the program is to supplement, not replace the students' resources.

Funding is assessed on a per term basis.

Bursary is assessed on the basis of financial need and determined through the SFP; funding usually capped at between \$1,000 - \$1,500 per term for Fall/Winter.

Bursary support is subject to available funding and is not guaranteed.



# **RECEIVING UNIVERSITY FUNDS**



Recipients notified by email.



Students must be enrolled in courses and registered active for funding to be released; funding applied to recipients' student account first to cover tuition and other student fees.



Refund can be requested where the award recipient has no outstanding balance. Students must provide the university with their banking information to allow for direct deposit of refunds to their bank accounts.



University reserves the right to recover funds if a student withdraws from the study period in which funds were awarded.



# Work/Study Program

# WORK/STUDY PROGRAMS

Approximately 1600 opportunities available annually under three programs

- RAY (Research at York)
- LEAP (Leadership, Engagement and Ambassadorship Program)
- General Work/Study

Opportunities open to:

- Full-time international undergraduate students
- Financial need is not a requirement

Competitive wages (min. wage to \$23/hr); capped at 15 hrs/wk for Fall/Winter and 35 hrs/wk for Summer

# **WORK/STUDY ELIGIBILITY FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**



# Valid study permit for the period of employment.

Meet the specific skills and experience requirements set by the sponsoring department.

Full time: enrolled in a minimum of 18 credits for Fall/Winter (min. 9 credits or more per term). Full-time student with a disability: Enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits for Fall/Winter (min. 6 credits or more per term).

All student financial transactions (i.e., tuition, awards, residence, refunds and payments) are reflected on the online Student Account accessible through Passport York.



Statements are released **online** between the 18th and 20th of each month. They are not mailed.



Payments made through financial institution by phone or online banking. York University is the payee and student number is the "account" number.




