

Adding your courses

- Second tab, <u>Enrol in Courses</u> This will bring you to the Registration and Enrolment Module
- Select your academic session 'FALL/WINTER 2024'
- Select "Add a Course"
- Paste the CAT# from the Class Schedule you copied
- Select "Add Course"
- Finally, select "Yes" to confirm.
- Repeat until all courses have been added.




What are FA 1900's?
