

# Arriving in Canada

Keep the following documents in your possession before you travel to Canada. Do not place these documents in your checked luggage.

## Immigration Documents You Should Bring

- Valid passport
- Valid Temporary Resident Visa (TRV), Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA), or [official status U.S. status document](#)
- [Letter of introduction](#) that the visa office sent you when they approved your study permit [unless you do not need one](#) OR a valid study permit if you are a returning student and it was previously issued.
- York University Letter of Acceptance (via [MyFile](#))
- [Proof of Enrolment](#)
- Proof of funds to support your stay in Canada, such as a current bank statement. If you paid your tuition you can download a statement via [your student account](#).
- Valid immigration [medical exam](#) results, if applicable. The exam must be valid for 12 months from the day you get it and must be valid the day you enter Canada.
- Check [travel restrictions](#)

If applicable:

- English Language Proficiency Exam Results (hard copy)
- Medical and immunization records
- [Spouses and dependents](#) of International Students
