The Politics and Global Studies (PGS) program limited capacity. In light of this limitation, the PGS Program Board has decided to accept only 2 students each semester from all the exchange student applicants to PGS. In the case where the number of applicants exceeds the seats available, only the student(s) with the highest GPAX will be accepted. So the acceptance could not be guaranteed.

Regarding the **BBA program at Chulalongkorn Business School**, due to its consistent popularity, we are expecting a larger number of students for the Spring semester. Consequently, we have decided to decrease the intake of exchange students for the fall semester. This measure aims to effectively handle class overcrowding and ensure the highest quality of education for all students. For students interested in applying to the BBA program at Chulalongkorn University, we kindly suggest considering applying for the Spring semester to enhance the chances of a successful application.

Once the successful applicants are announced, It is not possible to start a new selection process owing to a tight schedule. Therefore, the students who have applied to but are rejected by the program will not be able to apply/change to other programs. We would appreciate your kind assistance in advising the students about these matters.

We do not recommend that exchange students take classes outside of their major since the program at Chula currently places great importance on the foundational knowledge of applicants. While in some cases it might be possible for exchange students to take courses outside of their host program, the exchange students need to go through some documentation on-site (e.g., course registration request) which they need to discuss with the program coordinator once they get accepted into the program. However, the possibility varies depending on the specific program's policies.
