Course Level

Elementary Course (JLPT N4, CEFR A2 level)

This course is for students who are JLPT N4 or CFER A2 level equivalent. Students at this level can understand sentences on familiar topics using basic vocabulary and can understand everyday conversation if spoken slowly.

Students without any experience studying Japanese language are not eligible to apply.

Intermediate Course (JLPT N3-N2, CEFR B1 level)

This course is for students who are JLPT N3^{N2} or CEFR B1 level or equivalent. Students at this level can understand some near-natural speed conversation used in everyday situations and state their opinions on familiar and common topics.

Students at advanced level are not eligible to apply.
