1. RESEARCH AND PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES

1.1. CALL FOR YORK FACULTY-LED STUDY ABROAD COURSES AND PROGRAMS (2025 & 2026)

York International (YI) is accepting proposals for faculty-led study abroad courses and programs for 2025 and 2026.

YI offers many supports to faculty leads and instructors including international partnership support, program and budget planning and vendor-service provider coordination, student recruitment and promotions, logistical arrangements, student funding, safety abroad training and travel risk management. Students will also be eligible for York International Mobility Award (YIMA) upon completion of safety abroad training and procedures.

1.2. 2024 INTERNATIONAL POLICY IDEAS CHALLENGE

Global Affairs Canada (GAC), in collaboration with the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council (SSHRC), announced the seventh edition of the International Policy Ideas Challenge. The objective of the program is to draw on the network of talented Canadian graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, and early-career civil society researchers to identify concrete, innovative solutions to emerging international policy challenges faced by Canada.

Eligibility: Current graduate students (Master's or PhD level) and post-doctoral fellows at a recognized Canadian post-secondary educational institution. Applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada.
