2.1. NAVEEN JINDAL YOUNG GLOBAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

This program offers a fully funded residential opportunity spanning three months to outstanding Ph.D. students and faculty members from esteemed universities worldwide. 2.2. TUM GLOBAL POSTDOC FELLOWSHIP

2.4. DOCTORAL SCHOLARSHIP FROM THE ROSA LUXEMBOURG FOUNDATION

Rosa-Luxemburg-Stiftung grants scholarships to foreigners who go to Germany for their dissertation or to conduct research as a part of their dissertation.

2.12. GERMAN BUNDESTAG: INTERNATIONAL PARLIAMENTARY SCHOLARSHIPS (IPS)

German Bundestag, in cooperation with Freie Universität, Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, and Technische Universität Berlin, awards up to 120 IPS scholarships annually to young university graduates from 50 nations (Central, Eastern or Southeastern Europe, France, Israel, North America, Latin America, Asia-Pacific or the Arab region, Namibia or South Africa). The scholarship holders are familiarized with the various tasks of a parliamentarian's office and accompany their members to meetings of committees, parliamentary groups and other bodies and gain insights into the internal functions, interrelationships and procedures of parliament.

- Citizenship of a participating country (dual nationality is permitted)
- University degree
- Very good knowledge of the German language
- Under 30 years old at the start of the scholarship

This specialized DAAD program offers German Studies Research Grants to highly-qualified undergraduate and graduate students who are nominated by the professor supervising their research project. The grant may be used for short-term research (one to two months) in Germany. The program is designed to encourage research and promote the study of cultural, political, historical, economic and social aspects of modern and contemporary German affairs from an inter- and multidisciplinary perspective.
