2.1. FACULTY MOBILITY FOR PARTNERSHIP BUILDING PROGRAM COMPETITION

Global Affairs Canada has launched the 2025-2026 Faculty Mobility for Partnership Building Program (FMPBP) competition. This program, which is accepting applications until November 19, 2024 at 11:59pm EST, provides full-time faculty at Canadian post-secondary institutions with opportunities to create or expand partnerships with Latin American and Caribbean institutions through short-term teaching and/or research activities.

As the scholarship administrator for the program, the Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE) will be offering representatives from Canadian institutions an informational webinar in English on **October 17, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. EST**.

2.2. DAAD (GERMANY) RESEARCH STAYS FOR ACADEMICS AND SCIENTISTS

2.4. INDO-PACIFIC REGIONAL CONNECTIVITY ENVELOPE- CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The Regional Connectivity Envelope is one of the new programs created under the **Indo-Pacific Engagement Initiative (IPEI)**. The IPEI, funded under <u>Strategic Objective #3</u> ('Investing in and connecting people') of Canada's Indo-Pacific Strategy, will support and enable Canadians to build new networks in the Indo-Pacific, strengthen Canada's voice on priority issues and create partnerships on behalf of Canada.

The Indo-Pacific Regional Connectivity Envelope (RCE) is a one-stage application process. Eligible organizations will submit a completed proposal that describes their proposed project and its alignment to <u>Canada's Indo-Pacific Strategy</u> (IPS).

The RCE is designed to connect Canadian researchers, institutions (including academic institutions, research centres, think tanks, cultural organizations and associations, non-profit chambers of commerce or business associations, advocacy groups, notably those representing Indigenous Peoples (Inuit, Métis and First Nations), women, youth and LGBTQ2+ communities) and organizations with regional stakeholders, rightsholders and counterparts.

2.5. THE BRITISH ACADEMY VISITING FELLOWSHIPS 2025

The British Academy's Visiting Fellowships programme provides outstanding academics based in any country overseas with the opportunity to be based at a UK higher education or other research institution. The programme is open to academics at any career stage, and in any discipline within the humanities and social sciences.

2.6. DAAD (GERMANY) RESEARCH GRANTS

The research grant offers the opportunity to realise a research project in Germany. The programme supports research stays during a doctorate or in the early postdoc phase.

2.7. FRANCE CANADA RESEARCH FUND

The France Canada Research Fund is a major instrument of Franco-Canadian scientific cooperation, created in 2000 through an agreement between the French Embassy in Canada



and a consortium of 23 Canadian universities. Laureates are awarded start-up grants of CA\$8,000 to \$15,000 to fund research and student mobility between the two countries.

- The FCRF is open to all fields of research.
- Applications must be for joint projects with a French institution.
- The FCRF only funds new collaborations, and researchers who apply must never have worked together before. It is essential that researchers include students and young researchers in their work teams.
- Member universities may submit up to five applications. Pre-selected applications are evaluated in a second phase by committees of French and Canadian experts. The FCRF Executive Committee then decides on the final allocation of grants at its annual meeting.

2.8. MITACS: GLOBALINK RESEARCH AWARD (GRA) THEMATIC CALL

The Study Abroad Program at Las Nubes EcoCampus offers several courses during the academic year, through which students are given an unprecedented opportunity to interact with and learn from the local rural Costa Rican communities through first-hand lessons on tropical ecology, sustainability, indigenous education, arts, health, and conservation.

Germany. The program is designed to encourage research and promote the study of cultural, political, historical, economic and social aspects of modern and contemporary German affairs from an inter- and multidisciplinary perspective.
