EDUCATION IN NUMBERS

- Some 50,000 students (equivalent to around 30,000 full-time students)
- Around 75 undergraduate programmes
- Around 75 Master's programmes
- Roughly 2,000 freestanding courses
- Most popular programmes: law, medicine and psychology
- Around 6,800 degrees per year (50% at Master's level)
- Some 70 international Master's programmes
- Around 900 freestanding courses in English
- International student exchanges: approximately 1,000 incoming students and 400 outgoing
- Some 1,650 fee-paying students from third countries (equivalent to approx. 1,000 full-time students)

RESEARCH AND PHD PROGRAMMES IN NUMBERS

- Around 200 PhD subject areas
- Some 2,400 PhD students (50% women)
- More than 300 PhD degrees per year
- Some 5,600 peer-reviewed scholarly publications per year
- Revenue for research and PhD programmes: Approx. SEK 5,400 million (70% of total turnover)
- Over 50% of research funding comes from external sources
