


A study permit is required to study in Canada for any program that is over 6 months long unless you are a permanent resident or Canadian citizen.

Put your best foot forward with your first application. Ensure you include all mandatory and supporting documents.

Don't underestimate the importance of this application. Decisions are up to the discretion of the officer. Nobody can guarantee a result for you.

If you wish to provide additional documents or update your application, you can complete an <u>IRCC webform</u>. Family members who are not working or studying may apply to come as visitors.



Applying from inside Canada

If you apply from inside Canada while on visitor or worker status, you CANNOT start studying until your study permit is approved.

Who can apply from inside Canada?

Only some people can <u>apply from</u> <u>inside Canada.</u> Notably:

- Ukrainians
- minor children in secondary school
- If you, your parent or your spouse has a valid study/work permit
- If you are not eligible to apply from inside Canada, you should apply from outside Canada and wait for approval before making travel plans.

I have a study permit. Can I continue using it?

Check the expiry date and the conditions. If your study permit<u>isn't</u> expiring soon and you have the conditions to work on/off campus on your study permit, you can continue to use it. You must <u>update your DLI online</u> before you start your courses at York.


If your study permit is expiring soon or you need to change the conditions on your study permit, you **must apply** for an extension **before** your current study permit expires. You should apply as soon as you get your letter of acceptance to York.

How is the application different?

When applying from inside Canada, you apply for your study permit first. If you need a new visa, you will apply for it after you receive your new study permit.

The IMM forms and the document checklist may look different for those applying from inside Canada.





Receive a final decision. If your application is approved, you will receive a letter of introduction and passport request letter if required.

Your application to study in Canada has been approved. A permit authorizing your studies will be issued to you on your arrival to Canada following an examination by an officer of the Canada Border Services Agency, subject to your compliance with the requirements of the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and its Regulations. The officer will ask to see this letter, your passport and may request to see your supporting documents, such as the letter of acceptance from your educational institution. Do not pack these or other valuable papers in your checked luggage. You can find out more about which documents you will need to bring with you by visiting www.cic.gc.ca/english/study/study-arriving.asp.

As you gather your documents, please take note of the following:


- · This letter is not a passport or travel document. You will not be permitted to board your fight without your passport, even if you have this letter with you.
- This letter is not an authorization permitting you to enter or remain in Canada. An officer of the Canada Border Services Agency will make that determination upon your arrival to Canada.
- · This letter is important because it contains information that will be used by the Canada Border Services. Agency to issue your study permit. Please do not misplace it.

You must seek entry to Canada to obtain your study permit by 2022(07/30 (yyyy/mm/dd). Your passport must be valid beyond the period you intend to remain in Canada. If not, the validity of your study permit will not be issued beyond the expiny date of your passport, or, for United States citizens and permanent residents, the validity date of your identity document.

Note: As an international student in Canada, it is your responsibility to ensure that you continue to meet the conditions of your study permit, including the requirement to actively pursue studies. Your study permit will automatically become invalid 90 days after you complete your study program, regardless of the expiry date indicated on your study permit. What if I have accompanying family members?

Your spouse/common-law partner and/or dependant children may apply to accompany you to Canada. Their applications can be made together with yours or separately after your study permit is approved.

<u>Minor children intending to study in Canada</u> should apply for a study permit (no letter of acceptance is required.

A spouse or common law partner who meets the eligibility criteria may apply for an open work permit.

If your accompanying family members are not working or studying, they should apply to come as visitors.

Where do I get my letter of acceptance to York?

You can find it in MyFile. Verify your LOA includes tuition, start date, the DLI#, etc. Letters of acceptance are issued once.

Under "supporting documents" will be a list of the documents you need to upload and a separate column indicating whether the documents were received by York. You can screenshot this page and include it to as part of the proof you have cleared your admissions conditions.

What if my letter of acceptance is conditional?

If you have a <u>conditional letter of acceptance</u>, you can and should still apply for a study permit. "Full acceptance" letters are not generally issued.

What do I write in my study plan?

- Confirm whether or not you have a prerequisite course
- Explain that you have submitted all documents requested by the University to finalize your admission e.g. transcripts, etc. (If you cannot do this explain why and state when you will provide them)
- Attach a screenshot of the "supporting documents" page from your MyFile



ESL and prerequisites: If you must complete a prerequisite course or program before you begin your studies, your study permit will typically be valid for up to 1 year after completing your prerequisite. Even if your prerequisite program is short, you should apply for a study permit from outside Canada and wait for approval before travelling.







2 PROOF OF FINANCIAL ABILITY

Do I need to provide proof of paid tuition?

Check your local visa office instructions.

- Even if you are not required to prepay tuition, it can help strengthen your application if you do.
- Paying tuition fully or partially can lend credibility to the fact that you are a genuine student, with genuine intentions to study in Canada.

What documents do I need to show paid tuition?

- You can <u>make a deposit</u> of any amount and a payment receipt will be added to your <u>MyFile</u> in 4-5 working days from the date the payment is received.
- Your deposit will be posted to your student account and applied toward your fees when they are due.
- Proof of paid tuition **can include** a receipt from your bank confirming that the payment was submitted to York University.









You should be prepared to demonstrate the ability to fund (liquid funds) one full year of cost in Canada including:

- Your first year of tuition fees as indicated on your letter of acceptance
- Travel expenses to get to and from Canada, and
- Minimum cost-of-living (CAD \$20,635)

BUDGETING FOR YOUR EDUCATION

As part of your study permit application, you will need to show that you have sufficient funds to support yourself (and any accompanying family members) while you are in Canada.

Take time to sit down with your family to discuss your finances.

- What costs will you have: flights, tuition, housing, food, books, health insurance, entertainment, etc?
- Where will your funds be coming from?
- How often will funds be sent to you?
- What if there is an emergency, inflation or currency conversions are not in your favour?
- Note that while you may be eligible to work while you are in Canada, it is meant to provide you with valuable work experience to boost your resume. You must be able to support yourself without relying on work in Canada.
- While there are some scholarships and bursaries available to international students, these will also not fund your entire education.

Proof of financial ability

IRCC wants to see that you have strong proof of financial support. Insufficient proof is one of the most common reasons for refusal.

Your letter of acceptance will indicate:

- The cost of tuition for one year
- Books/personal expenses
- Residence/meal plans
- Health care

You should be prepared to demonstrate the ability to fund (liquid funds) one full year of tuition, return airfare and a **minimum** of \$20,635 for your first year of living expenses (additional if accompanying family <u>members</u>)

Sources of funds must be **clear**, **sufficient** and **reliable**. • If your funds are being provided by a parent or family member, they must provide proof of *where* the funds are coming from e.g. letter of employment, proof of business ownership, bank statements, etc. Additionally, it is important that your sponsor provides a letter (preferably notarized) explaining how they will support your studies in Canada.

• Third party funds (funds from anyone other than yourself or your parents): not preferred. They will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.





Write a brief summary confirming that you meet the eligibility requirement for having sufficient fund

What is a study plan?

- A study plan is like a **cover letter of 1-2 pages**
- To establish that your true intention is to seek a permit to study in Canada
- The purpose of your study plan is to demonstrate to IRCC that you a genuine student and that you have sufficient ties to your home country/residence.
- You should be specific, factual and practical in your study plan.









Guiding questions for the study plan

Why do you want to study at York University? Why this step in your education journey is logical/beneficial? Why can't you do it in your home country or neighbouring countries? How your studies will help your employment prospects (provide proof where possible e.g. letter from an employer who will hire you on your return)?

Pay your deposit within 10 business days of accepting your offer.

Whether or not you need a PAL to apply for a study permit, the **\$2,000 non-refundable acceptance** deposit is required to maintain your offer.

Step 1: Accept Your Offer

If you have received an offer letter but have not yet accepted it, we advise you to accept your offer letter

Step 2: Pay Your Non-Refundable Acceptance Deposit

Paying your deposit allows you to be registered and will ensure that you are issued a PAL, if eligible.

Step 3: Access Your Attestation Letter in MyFile

The PAL will become available in <u>MyFile</u> within 3-5 business days following the successful receipt of your deposit and the request form.

Please be advised that a student number and date of birth are required to log into MyFile

- Once logged into <u>MyFile</u>, please navigate to the "Admissions Documents" link on the lefthand sidebar.
- If there is no link to the PAL then the letter has not yet been processed by the Ministry and is not yet available — please check back within 24-72 hours

Provincial Attestation Letter

If you've already paid a portion or your full acceptance deposit – Great!

- Please pay the full amount if you haven't already
- The Admissions team will see you've paid and begin the PAL process for you

If you think you may be eligible for domestic fees

- Still pay the \$1500 acceptance deposit it will be applied to your tuition fees
- Domestic fee eligibility will not be assessed in time to accept your offer
- Check your eligibility: <u>https://sfs.yorku.ca/fees/academic-tuition-fee-categories</u>
- Documentation must be provided, ie. copy of a parent's work permit

Fall/Winter Session

- October 31: deadline for a reassessment of a complete fall/winter session.
- January 31: deadline for a reassessment of a winter term only.

Summer Session Deadline

- June 30: deadline for a reassessment of a complete summer session.

If you've received a scholarship

• Still pay the \$2,000 acceptance deposit – your scholarship fees will be applied to your student account in September before your tuition fees are due







Other documents

- <u>Medical exam</u> if required, it is highly recommended to complete this upfront
- Valid passport (check the expiry date, try to ensure you have at least 4 years remaining before expiry)
- Visa photo
- Biometrics
 - \circ 14 years old and up
 - Not required if completed in the last 10 years
 - Pay the \$85 fee with your application and instructions to complete biometrics will follow
- Any forms or other documents <u>required by your visa</u> <u>office</u>

What language should my supporting documents be in? All documents must be in English or French. If they are translated, you must provide the translation, a certified photocopy of the original and an affidavit from the person who completed the translation.

Quick tips

Use "?" button to view additional instructions or examples

Merge together and upload all additional documents under "client information"

- Study plan, financial support cover letter, etc.
- Check your letter of acceptance and passport for information. Make sure to copy exactly.
- Ensure your forms are complete, accurate and validated. If there isn't enough space on the form, attach an extra sheet.
- There is no need to print/sign your application if you are applying online. Answer truthfully, especially for the background information questions. Provide explanations for any "yes" answers.
 - Take screenshots: once documents are uploaded, submission page, "successfully submitted" page Be sure to check your spam/junk mail for correspondence from IRCC and regularly check your online
 - account

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You have to type your name and answer a security question to submit your application. This is your electronic signature. **Do not** print out your application form to sign it.

to sign your online application:

1) Type your name in the boxes.

Your given name and last name must be **exactly** the same as on your application form. If you're under the age of 18, your parent or guardian must sign your form for you.



2) Answer the security question.

This will be one of the four security questions you created when you registered your <u>account</u>. You must answer exactly as you did when you created them.





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

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COMMON REFUSAL REASONS





Unclear and/or insufficient financial documents

Write a cover letter that includes: Your name, date of birth and UCI number (if you have one) The title "Proof of Funds and Financial Support" A brief summary confirming that you meet the eligibility requirement for

- having sufficient funds
- funds to cover these costs.

A list of the documents you are providing and a brief description

• Example:

1. Bank statements from November 2022 – April 2023, of my father, [name] (Balance: CAD \$)....pages 1-10

2. Proof of property ownership for my mother, [name].....pages 11-13 3. Proof of employment for my [spouse/father/mother]....pages 13-16 4. Proof of funding from York University [e.g. graduate student

funding/scholarship]....page 17

Not satisfied you will leave at the end of your stay

- What aspects of your life bind you to your home country?
