

ARRIVING IN CANADA

Before You Travel to Canada



Before travelling to Canada, ensure you have all necessary documents ready:
Valid travel document (e.g., TRV, eTA, or passport)
Port of Entry Letter of Introduction (study permit approval letter)
Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL) from your study province or territory
Letter of acceptance from YorkU (available in MyFile)
Proof of Enrolment
Proof of funds (clear, up-to-date bank statements for yourself & dependents) • Tuition Payment Confirmation (if paid, available in Statement)
Keep photocopies and digital scans of all required documents in your carry-on, not in checked luggage. Declare any amount of CAD \$10,000 or more at customs.
Additional Documents
Some additional documents may be required based on your situation:
English Language Proficiency Exam results (hard copy)
If you've been in a <u>designated country</u> for more than 6 months in the last year, are a medical student or will work in jobs which require a medical exam, bring a hard copy of a <u>valid medical exam</u> completed within 12 months of travelling
Medical and immunization records from home country including COVID-19 vaccination (s)
Proof of Address (apartment lease or on-campus Housing Offer Letter)
Phone number(s) of family member in Canada
Spouses & Dependents of International Students



The Study Permit issued to the students after verification by CBSA (Canadian Border Services Agency) officers at their first port of entry in Canada.



After Arriving in Canada



Once you arrive, there are a few key steps to complete:
