



TORONTO AIRPORT (YYZ) TO YORK UNIVERSITY (KEELE)

PUBLIC TRANSIT

Option 1: GO bus 40



**Airport YYZ
(Terminal 1)**

**Hwy 407 Bus
Terminal/Station**

Take the **GO bus 40**
(Richmond Hill Ctr) from
Pearson Airport Terminal 1
to Hwy 407 Bus Terminal



Take the **TTC subway**
from Hwy 407 Station
(Southbound) to York
University Station

Option 2: TTC Bus 52

Take the **TTC Bus 52** from
Airport Terminal 3 (Arrivals
Levels Columns C8-C12) to
Lawrence West Station



Take the **TTC subway**
from Lawrence West
Station (Northbound)
to York University

Option 3: UP express

Take the **UP express**
train from Pearson
Airport to Union Station



Take the **TTC Subway**
from Union Station
(Southbound) to York
University Station

OTHER OPTIONS



Taxi/Limousine: recommended for those who travel with a large amount of luggages

Terminal 1 - Arrival Level:

- Taxis: Door C
- Limos : Door C

Terminal 3 - Arrival Level:

- Taxis: Door E
- Limos: Door E



Duration: 20-30 min (from the YYZ airport to York University Keele campus)



Cost : ~ \$60. This costs more than public transit, but it is more convenient if you are travelling with a large amount of luggages



Students should be prepared to pay with Canadian dollars or with Visa/Mastercard



Avoid scams by using the designated taxi stands in the airport and checking for proper identification



App-Based Transportation (Uber, Lyft, etc)

Terminal 1 - Arrival Level:

- Ground level, door Q

Terminal 3 - Arrival Level:

- Arrival level, door D



Duration: 20-30 min (from the YYZ airport to York University Keele campus)



Cost : ~ \$40



Students should be prepared to pay with Visa or Mastercard



Please note that travelling during peak traffic times may cause higher fares

PUBLIC TRANSIT IN TORONTO

Toronto's public transit system includes buses, streetcars, subways, and commuter rail. The **Toronto Transit Commission (TTC)** operates most of the local transit (subways, streetcars, buses) and is the most commonly used method to get around Toronto. Meanwhile, **GO Transit** connects Toronto to the surrounding region



The Toronto Transit Commission (TTC)



Services: streetcars, buses, subways

Fare: \$3.30 for adult, \$2.35 for youth using Presto card




GO Transit



Services: trains and buses

Fare: dependent on the distance you are travelling

Payment method



Presto Card



Tap to pay

Toronto's public transit can all be paid by Presto, credit, or debit card

- ✓ Transfer between modes (TTC) within a two-hour window for free
- ✓ No matter what transit agency you use, you can always pay the lowest with Presto card
- ✓ Ask the staffs for help if you are confused about how to pay or how to get to your destination
