York University acknowledges its presence on the traditional territory of many Indigenous Nations. The area known as Tkaronto has been care taken by the Anishinabek Nation, the Haudenosaunee Confederacy, and the Huron-Wendat.

It is now home to many First Nation, Inuit and Métis communities. We acknowledge the current treaty holders, the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation. This territory is subject of the Dish with One Spoon Wampum Belt Covenant, an agreement to peaceably share and care for the Great Lakes region.






- 9 undergraduate residence buildings

Room Styles

Traditional-Style

- > Standard Double and Single rooms
- Sharing common washrooms and lounges where cleaning is provided
- ➤ Preferred choice for first-year students looking to make new friends and not worry about cooking/cleaning for themselves
- ➤ Dining plan is required

Suite-Style

- Single and Double rooms within a suite
- Washrooms and kitchen shared by other students in the suite
- Preferred choice for upper-year students who may like to cook and clean for themselves
- > Dining plan is optional







- Located off-campus (1.2km away from the Markham Campus) in downtown Markham
- Single and Double Rooms in shared 3-4 person suites
- Single-Gender and Mixed-Gender Suites
- Free shuttle transportation to Markham Campus
- No dining plan option available, insuite kitchen is provided


Students living in a Traditional-Style residence are required to purchase a Dining Plan. Dining Plans are optional for students living in a Suite-Style Residence.


> Applications for the 2025-2026 term are currently available through the Apply for Residence page at yorku.ca/housing

 - Please note: students will only receive an offer for residence once they
 have been accepted into a full-time degree program at York


- > Navigate to the York University Housing website
 - YorkU.ca/Housing
- > On the Prospective Keele Undergraduate Main Page, click "Apply"
 - This will take you to the Housing Portal page, we recommend bookmarking this for ease!
- > Login with your Passport York credentials
- > Click "Apply Now" to begin the application process!





Navigating the Application Process

- > The application process is expected to take 15-20 minutes
 - You do not need to complete it in one sitting and can return to it at any time!
- > The application will cover the following topics:
 - Applicant Information
 - Emergency Contact
 - Housing Preference
 - Room/Building Preferences
 - Lifestyle Preferences
 - Accommodated Housing
 - Dietary Accommodations and Preferences
 - Dining Plan Selection
 - Additional Information







A \$250 application fee is required to complete your application.

Application Cancellation Process

- > Students wishing to cancel their application and/or room reservation must complete the Application Cancellation Form
 - The Application Cancellation Form is located on the Housing & Conference Services website



Next Steps

- Residence offers will begin in March and continue throughout the Spring and Summer
- > To accept your Residence Offer, you will be required to pay a \$750 deposit to secure your space
- Once you have accepted your offer, you will be able to access Roommate Matching to select a Roommate
- > This summer, we are launching Room Self-Selection to allow students the opportunity to select their own room.
 - More information about Room Self-Selection will be made available in the coming months



4 Year International Student Residence Guarantee

First year international students coming directly from an out-of-province or foreign high school attending York University in Fall 2025 are guaranteed:

- a space in residence
- A 4-year on-campus housing/residence guarantee

if they have completed a housing application by May 1, 2025, and accept their admission by the deadline.

Students who may be eligible for the guarantee will have the opportunity to opt-in during their application process.










4Stay Marketplace

What is it?

- York University, in partnership with 4Stay, launched the 4Stay marketplace in Summer 2024 to assist York students seeking off-campus housing with their search
- The marketplace features listings located near the Keele and Markham campuses, and each listing is vetted by 4Stay for safety and legitimacy
- Students can browse available listings, message landlords, and book their stay through the platform
- While most listings are for 12-month leases, there are limited shorter stays available on the 4Stay marketplace for those only looking for a one or two semester stay




Scan to access the 4Stay Marketplace






Navigating the 4Stay Marketplace

- Start by using the filters at the top of the page to begin narrowing down your search
 - Your budget and Housing Search Checklist will help you select the best filters for your search!
- Under Stay Type, you can select either Entire Place (an entire unit to yourself), Private Room (shared accommodations but with a private bedroom), or Shared Room (shared accommodations with a shared bedroom)
- Under Property Type, you can select either House, Apartment, Townhouse, Dorm, or Hostel
- Using the Price Slider, you can set a minimum and maximum price to establish your price range




