
Neighbourhood Exploration Danforth (Toronto's Greek Town) & Riverdale Park

Suggested Walking Route



Students can take the following suggested route.

- Board the train towards Finch from York University Subway Station to Donlands Subway Station (transfer from St.George to line 2 and board the train towards Kennedy)
- Walk west on Danforth Avenue towards Donlands Ave
- Walk South on Logan Avenue towards Danforth Avenue
- Explore along through Withrow Park (there are washroom facilities inside the park)
- Walk West on Hogarth Avenue towrad Hampton Avenue
- Broadview Subway Station to York University Subway Station



Fun Facts about Danforth Area



Danforth Avenue

- 10km long avenue from Don River Valley to Scarborough.
- One of oldest and operational theatre of Toronto, Danforth Music Hall is located here.
- You can try authentic greek cuisines at various restaurants and cafes located on this street.
- Cafes like <u>The Only Café</u>, <u>Square Boy Pizza</u> and <u>Athens Pastries</u> are top 3 spots to eat in Danforth Street.
- Danforth Avenue hosts a summer festival called <u>Taste of Danforth</u> where the entire street is closed for folks to have a culinary journey like no other.

Withrow Park

- Withrow Park has an outdoor skating rink in the winters.
- From June 1 to October 19, the park hosts a Saturday Farmers Market from 9 AM 1 PM.
- You can rent one fire pit online for BBQ.
- Park has a café called Riverdale Perk Café.
