

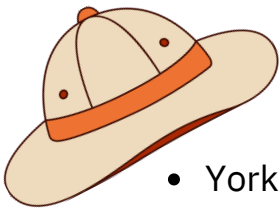
# Toronto Harbourfront

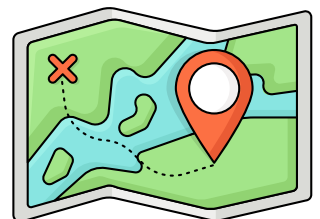
## Suggested Walking Route

- YorkU subway to Union Station
- Union Station to Harbourfront Centre (509/510 Streetcar)
- Walk west along Queens Quay West
- Walk North on Bathurst Street
- Walk East along King Street
- St. Andrew Station to York University Subway Station



# Key Places to Explore

## Toronto Waterfront

- Harbourfront Centre hosts many free events throughout the year, like outdoor concerts, movies nights and cultural festivals.
- Stroll along the 3.5km boardwalk connecting various parks, attractions and cultural spaces.
- Explore Billy Bishop Toronto City Airport to watch small planes take off one of the countries shortest runways.
- Take a ferry ride to the Toronto Island Park to spend the day at Centre Island, Hanlan's Point or Ward's Island with beaches, parks and bicycle trails.



## Toronto Music Garden

- One of the many unique parks along the Toronto waterfront.
- Located at Queens Quay West at Lower Spadina Avenue.
- Designed by Yo-Yo Ma a world renowned American cellist.
- Each section represents a movement from Bach's suite No. 1 in G Major for Unaccompanied Cello, blending art, nature, and music.
- Enjoy live classical and world music performances in the summer.



## STACKT Market

- Canada's largest shipping container market. A creative space built from repurposed shipping containers.
- Discover unique fashion, home goods and handmade products with local shops and pop-up retailers.
- Check out ongoing events for frequent art installations, DJ sets and cultural festivals.
- Enjoy some good eats from well-known local chefs at FatBao, Kong's Hot Tacos and My Ding-a-Wing.
- Relax with stunning city skyline views and open seating areas.
